A position has become available for a Research Assistant (with a bachelors degree) to work on a project investigating the neural correlates of peer rejection in adolescent depression. We are looking for someone to analyse an existing functional magnetic resonance imaging (fMRI) dataset from a sample of depressed and non-depressed adolescents (see Platt et al., 2014; Journal of Psychiatric Research). The applicant should be confident in working in English and prepared to contribute to the writing of scientific publications that result from the project.

### Requirements

- A very good undergraduate degree in Psychology or Neuroscience
- Experience in analysing MRI data (ideally functional MRI data)
- Experience in using SPM (or ideally FSL)
- Fluent in using SPSS
- Ability to work independently
- Fluent in written and spoken English
- Excellent communication skills
- Experience in writing scientific publications
