### WHAT IS IT ABOUT?

Previous work has demonstrated that individuals' emotions can be organized in an abstract space that corresponds to aspects of their personalities. While differences between individuals can be explained by factors such as personality, what remains unknown is the degree to which different abstract spaces (e.g., emotional, semantic, etc.) may be more or less distinct based on one's personality traits, and whether such distinctions can be indicative of other important characteristics of an individual (e.g., resilience to trauma, susceptibility to disease, etc.).
